



## May Minutes of the NTAPT meeting

Meeting Date: May 10, 2019  
Host District: Frisco ISD  
Location: 10701 Dallas Parkway Frisco, Texas

Terry Penn called the meeting to order at 10:32 am and welcomed everyone to the meeting. We said the Pledge of Allegiance and the Texas Pledge. Mr. Penn introduced our Frisco host, Ms. Koreen Severance. Mr. Penn recognized the 4 vendors sponsoring this last meeting of the year: Southwest International, Pro Air, Pinnacle and Gatekeeper. Remember to thank all our sponsors. Mr. Penn called for any new attendees and vendors to stand and give their name.

Today's meeting is for electing next year's officers. Mr. Penn recognized out going committee chairs with plaques: Scholarship Committee Chair – Tammy Loveless; Poster Committee Chair – April Shaw; Speech Contest Chair – Pat Garica; Rodeo Committee Chair – Raymond Forsberg; Special Needs Rodeo Committee Chair – Carol Barnhardt; and outgoing Executive Committee Officers with plaques: Historian – Laura Carter; Secretary – Dawn Loftin; Treasurer – Anna Hamrick; Past Pres - Beverly Shannon; and Raymond Forsberg (Pres Elect): Terry Penn introduced Raymond Forsberg as the Current President for 2019-2020 school year.

Mr. Forsberg thanked Mr. Penn for his service and presented him with a plaque. Mr. Forsberg called for motion to accept the April meeting minutes, motion was made, 2<sup>nd</sup>, no discussion, carried with no opposition. Anna Hamrick gave treasurer's report: Beg balance 12,229.43 +2440.00 (Roadeo dues, roadeo dontations) (Seon paid \$545.00 of April meal);+ 0.09 interest, less-April meal \$1091.00, -Roadeo supplies \$172.57, for a grand balance of \$11,945.20. Mr. Forsberg called for a motion to accept the treasurer's report as read, motion was made, 2<sup>nd</sup> and carried with no opposition.

Mr. Forsberg called for Chuck Gardner with Goolsbee Tire Service to talk about TASBT breaking away from TAPT and having a conference, separate from TAPT. This will be held in Waco July 19 -22, 2019. Mr. Forsberg introduced the 2 scholarship winners, Anna Smith from Plano and Skylar Forsberg from Duncanville. Both said a brief thank you for their scholarships.

Mr. Forsberg called up Beverly Shannon to start up elections of candidates. Ms. Shannon explained we will start voting and in order to be eligible to vote, you must be a member in good standing. Please come to myself or Dawn Lofitn to get your voting sheets. For office of President Elect: Ed Ostrander, Wylie ISD; David Hannah, CFB ISD; Scott Stewart, Crandall ISD; Secretary: Leigh Giddens, North Dallas Service Center DISD; Treasurer: Lori Fairless, Prosper ISD; Historian: Beverly Shannon, Plano ISD; Ex-Officio, Terry Penn (not on the ballot). Please step out and vote and we will get them counted today.

Mr. Forsberg talked about the rodeo and thanked everyone who attended and helped out through all the weather. Wanted to have all the sheets ready for all entries, but will try to get regional papers and packets out to those going on to State. Mr. Forsberg called Carol Barnhardt up to announce Special Needs winners. Ms. Barnhardt thanked Roger Peterson with Bucks Wheel along with the person who rode the wheelchair lift up and down all day. Ms. Barnhardt wanted to acknowledge and thank Region 11, Grapevine Colleyville for hosting this years Rodeo and announced winners: SPED TEAM Region 11 2<sup>nd</sup> place with 572 pts Argyle ISD Angelica E and Ronnie P; 1<sup>st</sup> place with 863 pts Robert K and William R (3<sup>rd</sup> year to compete at State level. SPED TEAM Region 10 3<sup>rd</sup> place with 831 pts Frisco ISD, Kathleen S and Linda J; 2<sup>nd</sup> place with 874 pts Plano ISD, Emad S and Katina R; 1<sup>st</sup> place with 881 pts Plano ISD, Stewart S and Logan H.

Mr. Forsberg announced winners of regular rodeo: Region 11 Transit – 1<sup>st</sup> place with 375 pts, Grapevine Colleyville, Linda P; Region 11 Conventional: 3<sup>rd</sup> place with 435 pts Bridgeport ISD, Euro Q; 2<sup>nd</sup> place with 501 pts Decatur ISD, Christy H; 1<sup>st</sup> place with 586 pts Bridgeport ISD, Laura R. Region 10 Transit all from Allen ISD 3<sup>rd</sup> place with 536 pts Delee L; 2<sup>nd</sup> place with 553 Mitzi B; 1<sup>st</sup> place with 564 pts Jeff T. Region 10 Conventional; 3<sup>rd</sup> place with 478 pts Wylie ISD, Sabrina L; 2<sup>nd</sup> place with 504 pts Wylie ISD, Glenn G; 1<sup>st</sup> place with 585 pts Garland ISD, Janet P. The awards were passed out to Special Needs and Transit on the day of the Rodeo, but with getting finished near 5pm, conventional nor plaques were not calculated until Monday after the Rodeo. Region 11 – parallel parking with 56 seconds, Justine T, Grapevine Colleyville and backup alley with 1 minute Christy H, Decatur ISD. Region 10 – parallel parking with 1 minute 2 seconds, Brittney L, Frisco ISD and backup alley with 54 seconds, Calvin N.

Pat Garcia spoke about the State speech contest held 4-29-19, 1<sup>st</sup> place 9<sup>th</sup> grade Lizzie G, Dripping Springs ISD, 10<sup>th</sup> grade Sophia A, Dripping Springs, 11<sup>th</sup> grade Isabel G, Banquete ISD, 12<sup>th</sup> grade Tia W, Banquete. Overall winner is Tia W from Banquete ISD. Mr. Garcia reminded about checking with all the classes that are available.

Mr. Forsberg called for hosting vendors to say a few words, Tim Dreilling with Southwest International; Brittney McNeil with SW Intl - On Command – connection presentation.

Mr. Penn called for a last call for voting, 3 times and declared voting closed. Mr. Forsberg then recognized Gatekeeper rep Bob Leblevic as being absent but still help to cosponsor the meeting, then called on Dr. Graves with Pinnacle Medical Management and Paul Rothschild with Pro Air.

Mr. Forsberg called Beverly Shannon up to announce the newly elected officers. Ms. Shannon announced that Historian, Secretary and Treasurer ran unopposed so they will automatically assume those positions. Ms. Shannon called up those running for President Elect. Ms. Shannon stated it was a very close race where Dawn and I counted and recounted the votes because that is how close it was and your newly elected President Elect is Scott Stewart from Crandall ISD. Ms Shannon said to not let this stop you from running next year because the vote was so very close.

Chuck Gardner reminded that TASBT Area 2 Director position is open at this time.

We did the drawings for prizes and passed them out. Mr. Penn blessed the meal. Mr. Forsberg called for motion to adjourn the meeting, motion was made and 2<sup>nd</sup>, no discussion, meeting adjourned.
